

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL  
Acceptance of Property Management Researcher  
P.L. 93-638 Grant Budget

RES. NO. 390-85

1 WHEREAS, Section 104(a) of P.L. 93-638 does authorize the granting of funds for  
2 the purpose of "strengthening and improvement of tribal government";  
3 and

4 WHEREAS, The Bureau of Indian Affairs has allocated \$213,900.00 of FY 1986  
5 funds for such grant purposes at the Papago Reservation; and

6 WHEREAS, The Papago Tribe does have need to strengthen and develop its Tribal  
7 government and management, by operating a Property Management  
8 Researcher in the amount of \$13,821.00.



10 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Papago Council does request the amount  
11 of at least \$213,900.00 for FY 1986 to be budgeted as review and  
12 approved by the Tribal Council. Any remaining balance of grant funds  
13 will be budgeted for indirect cost.

15 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the term of this grant shall commence on October  
16 01, 1985 and end September 30, 1986.

17 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Josiah Moore, Chairman; Francisco Jose, Jr., or  
18 Rosita Ruiz, Treasurer are hereby authorized to negotiate and sign  
19 whatever grant documents are required and further to negotiate and  
20 sign amendments and extensions to such grant.

22 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 7th  
23 day of June, 1985, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of  
24 1502.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting; and 5 absent, pursuant to the  
25 authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (a), (d) and (m) of Article  
26 V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended,  
27 ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary  
28 of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June  
29 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the  
30 Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by  
31 the Papago Council.
