

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

(Authorizing extension of term from October 1984)

RES. NO. 39-85

1 WHEREAS, The Papago Council did by Resolution No. 133-82 appoint Mr. Dewey
2 Ortega and Mr. Larry Martinez to two year terms (respectively) on the
3 Law & Order Committee and;

4 WHEREAS, The appointment of both Mr. Ortega and Mr. Martinez has expired in
5 October 1984 and;


6 WHEREAS, It is in the best interest of the Law & Order Committee and the Papago
7 Council that both Mr. Ortega and Mr. Martinez remain active to this
8 committee pending the review and clarification of their appointed terms
9 to the committee or pending action of the Papago Council of either
10 replacement or reappointment to this committee.

11 NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Papago Council extends the appointment
12 of Mr. Dewey Ortega and/or Mr. Larry Martinez from October, 1984 until
13 they may be replaced or reappointed to the Law & Order Committee of
14 the Papago Council and;


15 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Papago Council adopts this Resolution with the
16 clear understanding that it (Council) does not intend to continue with
17 inconsistent appointments where the Council has specified a term of
18 appointment for any of its committee members.

19 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 07th
20 day of February, 1985, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote
21 of 1114.0 for; 138.0 against; 188.0 not voting; and -0- absent, pursuant to
22 the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (e) and (f) of Article
23 V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended,
24 ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary
of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June
18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the
Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by
the Papago Council.
