

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

(Develop Job Description for Construction Inspector)

1 WHEREAS, The Papago Council has directed and authorized the advertisement of
2 construction work on certain 1984 HIP homes to be directed to O'odham
3 contractors interested in bidding for such construction; and


4 WHEREAS, The Papago Council is desirous of retaining and hiring a qualified
5 inspector to monitor and inspect the projects to ensure that required
6 and applicable regulations are being complied with; and

7 WHEREAS, It is the desire of the Papago Council to fully describe the require-
8 ments of the construction inspector;


9 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that the Executive Office
10 is hereby directed to develop and draft a job description and an-
11 nouncement for the position of construction inspector for the purpose
12 of monitoring and inspecting the construction work to be performed on
13 certain specified 1984 HIP homes by the selected O'odham Contractor(s).

14 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 7th
15 day of February, 1985, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote
16 of 1,333.0 for; -0- against; 107.0 not voting; and -0- absent, pursuant to
17 the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (h), (f), and (e) of
18 Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as
19 amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the
Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act
of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by
the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment
by the Papago Council.
