

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL
(Farm Board Waiver for Annual Report until March)

RES. NO. 41-85

1 WHEREAS, The Papago Farm Board is required by its Plan of Operations to report
2 on an Annual basis to the Papago Council; and

3 WHEREAS, The Papago Council did by Resolution No. 229-84 grant an extension to
4 the Papago Farming Authority until February, 1985, to receive the
5 Annual Report;


6 WHEREAS, The Papago Farming Authority had not been able to complete the report
7 to fully apprise the Papago Council of the status of Papago Farms and
8 is again requesting an extension;

9 WHEREAS, The Papago Council is satisfied that the reasons for the extension are
10 valid and warranted;

11 NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it hereby grants the
12 Papago Farming Authority's request to extend the Annual Report to the
13 Papago Council from February, 1985 until March, 1985.

14 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 07th
15 day of February, 1985, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote
16 of 1335.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting; and 02 absent, pursuant to the
17 authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (e) and (f) of Article V
18 of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended,
19 ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary
of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June
18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the
Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by
the Papago Council.
