

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

(Community Development Block Grant)

RES. NO. 47-85

1 WHEREAS, The Papago Tribe did solicit the participation of the eleven political
2 districts of the Papago Reservation for priority needs of their re-
3 spective districts; and

4 WHEREAS, The Papago Tribe did receive seven proposals from five districts for
5 prospective projects as follows:

- 6 1. Hickiwan - Early Childhood Building
- 7 2. Gu Vo - Housing Rehab
- 8 3. Pisinemo - Road Construction
- 9 4. Sells - Big Fields Multi-Purpose Building
- Sells Fire Station
- 10 5. San Lucy - Early Childhood Building
- 11 6. PTUA - Telephone Facility and equipment to house
telephone operation

12 WHEREAS, The Papago Council has determined to keep intends to apply for CDBG
13 Program funds for the purpose of above projects and that the Papago
14 Council supports, approves and authorizes the above districts and PTUA
15 to apply for such funds.


16 NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it hereby supports
17 approves, and authorizes the Hickiwan, Pisinemo, San Lucy, Sells and
18 Gu Vo Districts and further the Papago Tribal Utility Authority to
19 apply for CDBG Program funds to reconstruct and construct such facili-
20 ties and buildings;

21 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it hereby directs and author-
22 izes any and all appropriate officials to consult with and negotiate
23 for CDBG funding and to execute any and all contracts and legal docu-
24 ments and any amendments thereto which may be necessary to implement
25 the project.


26 LET IT BE FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that any profits derived from
27 the project over and above that which is necessary to meet the fi-
28 nancial obligations and criteria of the REA or other lending agencies,
29 PTUA shall use such funds for the long term continuance of the project
30 and further expansions as necessary and thereby furthering the Tribes
31 goal toward self-sufficiency and reducing its' dependency on Federal
32 Grants.

1 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 08th
2 day of February, 1985, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote
3 of 1,440.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting; and 01 absent, pursuant to the
4 authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (a) and (d) of Article V of
5 the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended, ratified
6 by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the
7 Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934
8 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the Secretary of
9 the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by the Papago
10 Council.
