and does hereby ask that Tribal Administration report

back to the Papago Council within six months concerning

the implementation of this resolution by law enforcement, court and other appropriate officials and officers

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 10th day of July , 1985, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,502.0 for; -0- against; 138.0 not voting; and -0- absent, pursuant to the authority vested in the Council by Section 2(e), (f) and (h) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the Secretary of Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by the Papago Council.
