RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL (Authorizing Operation of JTPA Programs)

RES. NO. 536-85

WHEREAS, The Papago Tribe, as grantee, operates JTPA Programs (Successor of the CETA Program) on the Papago Reservation through the Office of JTPA, Programs; and

WHEREAS, Both the CETA and JTPA Programs have been of great value to the Papago people, and it is essential to continue the JTPA Programs.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby authorize funding, development, operation and continuance of JTPA Programs on the Papago Reservation, through the Office of JTPA Programs, and does hereby authorize the Office of JTPA Programs to negotiate, and the Chairman or Vice-Chairman of the Papago Council to execute, any contract, agreement or document or amendments thereto, with the Federal or State governments, or any departments, agencies or subdivisions thereof, including schools and school districts, and with any private or public corporations or organizations, which are necessary or incidental to the funding, development, operation or continuance of such Programs on the Papago Reservation, hereby ratifying any act or acts of the Office of JTPA Programs or of the Chairman or Vice-Chairman of the Papago Council in negotiating or executing such contract, agreement or document, or any amendments thereto, for and on behalf of the Papago Tribe.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 10th day of July, 1985, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,640.0 for; -0 against; -0 not voting; and 01 absent, pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (a) (e) and (h) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by the Papago Council.
