


RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL
(Resolution amending Resolution No. 180-84)

RES. NO. 53-85

1 WHEREAS, The District Council of the HICKIWAN District did on August 11, 1984,
2 by Resolution No. 4-84 approve the attached FY 85 District Budget in
3 the amount of \$161,688.00; and
4 WHEREAS, The HICKIWAN District has sufficient funds in its IIM Account to
5 cover the budget; and
6 WHEREAS, The Papago Council did review the attached budget and approved of
7 same.
8 WHEREAS, The Papago Council enacted Resolution No. 180-84 authorizing the
9 HICKIWAN District Council to expend funds in accordance with its
10 FY 85 budget;
11 WHEREAS, Resolution 180-84 also authorized the transfer of District funds into
12 a Valley National Bank Account in Ajo in contradiction of the HICKIWAN
13 District's own resolution;
14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that the attached FY 85
15 budget of the HICKIWAN District approved by the Papago Council on
16 August 20, 1984 remain in force and that expenditures in accordance
17 therewith are authorized;
18 BE, IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby rescind that
19 part of Resolution 180-84 which authorized the transfer of District
20 funds into a Valley National Bank Account in Ajo and enacts this
21 amendment to Resolution 180-84 reflecting the intent of the HICKIWAN
22 District Council that all funds of the HICKIWAN District remain in
23 the IIM Accounts.
24 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 6th
25 day of March, 1985, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
26 1,440.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting; and -0- absent, pursuant to the
27 authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (f) of Article V of the
28 Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended, ratified
29 by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the
30 Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934
31 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the Secretary of
32 the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by the Papago
Council.
