

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL
(Proposed use hearings - Revenue Sharing Funds)

RES. NO. 540-85

1 WHEREAS, Federal regulations require that each recipient government which
2 expends federal revenue sharing entitlement funds shall, prior to the
3 revenue sharing budget hearing and enactment of the revenue sharing
4 budget, have at least one public hearing on the possible uses of such
5 funds, at which hearing all citizens of the recipient government shall
6 have the opportunity to provide such government with written and/or
7 oral comments and suggestions as to possible uses; and


8 WHEREAS, Federal revenue sharing laws and regulations provide for maximum
9 public participation and attendance at such public hearing(s), par-
10 ticularly from senior citizens and senior citizen organizations; and

11 WHEREAS, The Papago Council believes it to be in the best interest of the Tribe
12 that public hearings be conducted in each of the eleven Districts of
13 the Papago Reservation to receive comments and suggestions from members
14 of the Tribe on the possible uses of the Tribe's entitlement funds,
15 before the Papago Council conducts the final public revenue sharing
16 hearing and enacts the revenue sharing budget.

17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that public hearings on
18 the possible uses of entitlement funds be held in the eleven Districts
19 of the Papago Reservation and that the Accounting Office develop
20 guidelines for the calling, notice and conduct of such hearings, and
21 monitor such hearings and report to this Council in accordance with
22 the provisions of 31 C.F.R. §51.13.

23 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 10th
24 day of July, 1985, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
25 1,292.0 for; 290.0 against; 58.0 not voting; and 01 absent, pursuant to
26 the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (a), (e) and (f) of
27 Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as
28 amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by
the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of
the Act of June 81, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to
review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of
its enactment by the Papago Council.
