


RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL
(Papago Food Distribution & Family Nutrition Services)

RES. NO. 545-85


1 WHEREAS, The Papago Tribe has operated successfully a program whereby the diet
2 and nutritional needs of eligible Papago people have been served by
3 supplementing other federal social services programs; and
4 WHEREAS, The funding for the Papago Food Distribution/Family Nutrition Services
5 has been provided through the United States Department of Agriculture;
6 and
7 WHEREAS, The continued operation of the food distribution program is essential
8 to provide basic diet and nutrition for eligible clients; and
9 WHEREAS, A proposal for continued funding of the food distribution program has
10 been prepared by the Food Distribution program and is in accordance
11 with funding guidelines of USDA;
12 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the duration of this Grant will be from October
13 01, 1985 through September 31, 1986 unless extended by mutual
14 agreement of both contracting parties;
15 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that in the event this Grant is not in effect on
16 October 01, 1985 the existing FY'85 Grant will be continued until
17 such time as the FY'86 Grant is in effect; and
18 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Papago Council that the Papago Tribe will not
19 fund or operate the program in the interim while negotiations are
20 still being conducted and no executed Grant has been awarded by the
21 U.S. Department of Agriculture;
22 NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it hereby approves
23 the application for continued funding of the Papago Food Distribution/
24 Family Nutrition Services from the U.S. Department of Agriculture;
25 and
26 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Papago Council that Josiah Moore, Chairman,
27 Francisco Jose, Jr. Vice-Chairman or Rosita N. Ruiz, Treasurer, are
28 hereby authorized to apply for, and negotiate and execute any and all
29 contracts, amendments and other documents necessary to secure funding
30 for the continued operation of the Papago Food Distribution Program.
31 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 11th
32 day of July, 1985, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
1,640.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting; and -0- absent, pursuant to

1 the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (a) and (h) of Article
2 V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended,
3 ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secre-
4 tary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act
of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by
the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment
by the Papago Council.
