

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL  
(Approving Human Resource Agreement with  
USDA Forest Service)

RES. NO. 54-85


1 WHEREAS, Public Law 94-148 authorizes the Forest Service, USDA, to enter into  
2 cooperative agreements for the purpose of development and implemen-  
3 tation of a program of forest resource protection, development and  
4 improvement, and

5 WHEREAS, The Papago Tribe would benefit by the establishment of a cooperative  
6 manpower and job training and development programs, administered  
7 jointly by the Tribe and the Forest Service, which programs will  
8 provide valuable job training in conservation work for members of  
9 the Tribe.


10 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby approve  
11 the attached Human Resource Agreement with the Coronado National  
12 Forest, USDA Forest Service and authorizes the Chairman of the Papago  
13 Council to execute it on behalf of the Papago Tribe.

14 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 7th  
15 day of March, 1985, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of  
16 1,440.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting; and 02 absent, pursuant to the  
17 authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (a), (d), (e) and (f) of  
18 Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe as amended,  
19 ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary  
of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June  
18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the  
Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by  
the Papago Council.
