WHEREAS, The Papago Tribal Council has been advised by the Planning Office 1 that Plan and Specification has been prepared and completed with 2 Bashas, imput, reviewed and approval and are prepared to move in upon 3 confirmation of construction of the grocery store. 4 WHEREAS, The Papago Tribal Council has been further advised that with the 5 completion of plan and specification as is can be used to initiate 6 construction immediately of grocery store addition and improvement 7 in the Sells Shopping Center. 8 WHEREAS, The Papago Tribal Council has determined it is in the best interest 9 of the Papago Tribe to expedite the construction of the grocery store 10 additional improvement to have availability for the Papago people 11 the type of products and service the grocery store would bring about. 12 NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Papago Council hereby direct that the 13 treasury and the Executive Office make available tribal funds to 14 expedite and complete the construction of the grocery store as soon 15 16 as possible. The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 11th 17 day of July, 1985, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,492.0 for; -0- against; 148.0 not voting; and 02 absent, pursuant to the 18 authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (e) and (f) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended, 19 ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of 20 June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
