1 WHEREAS, The Papago Council has allocated \$51,573.73 of federal revenue sharing  
2 funds to the Sells District; and


3 WHEREAS, The Papago Council has heard evidence concerning the use of such funds  
4 pursuant to the requests presented at the public hearing, including  
5 the attached resolution of the District Council of the Sells District;

7 WHEREAS, The Papago Council has reviewed the attached budget and approves of  
8 the same.


9 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that the \$51,573.73 of  
10 federal revenue sharing funds allocated to the Sells District be  
11 distributed in accordance with the requests presented at the public  
12 hearing and that it does hereby approve the attached FY 85 revenue  
13 sharing budget of the Sells District and authorize expenditures in  
14 accordance therewith.

15 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 7th  
16 day of March, 1985, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of  
17 1,440.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting; and -0- absent, pursuant to the  
18 authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (a) and (d) of Article V  
19 of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended,  
20 ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary  
of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June  
18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the  
Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by  
the Papago Council.
