

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

(Low Income Home Energy Assistance Block Grant)

RES. NO. 615-85

1 WHEREAS, Block Grant appropriations have been made available for tribal grants
2 for FY-1986 for several state programs including Energy Assistance
3 Block Grant for Low Income Home Energy Assistance; and

4 WHEREAS, The Low Income Energy Assistance Block Grant is available through
5 the United States Department of Health and Human Services to Indian
6 Tribes meeting certain eligibility requirements; and

7 WHEREAS, It is in the best interest of the Papago Tribe to apply for FY-1986
8 Low Income Home Energy Assistance Block Grant; and


9 WHEREAS, The Papago Tribe believes that it will satisfy the eligibility
10 criteria set forth in the funding regulations.

11 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Papago Council does hereby authorize
12 the officials of the Papago Tribe to submit a request for Low Income
13 Home Energy Assistance Block Grant funding from the United States
14 Department of Health and Human Services.

15 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Josiah Moore, Chairman, Francisco Jose, Vice
16 Chairman or Rosita Ruiz, Treasurer of the Papago Council are hereby
17 authorized to negotiate and execute all necessary documents to request
18 FY-1986 funding for Low Income Energy Assistance Block Grant.

19 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 7th
20 day of August, 1985, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
21 1640.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting; and 3 absent, pursuant to the
22 authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (c), (d) of Article V of the
23 Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended, ratified by
24 the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the
25 Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934
26 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the Secretary of
27 the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by the Papago
28 Council.
