NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Papago Council does hereby authorize the officials of the Papago Tribe to submit a request for Low Income Home Energy Assistance Block Grant funding from the United States

Department of Health and Human Services.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Josiah Moore, Chairman, Francisco Jose, Vice

Chairman or Rosita Ruiz, Treasurer of the Papago Council are hereby

authorized to negotiate and execute all necessary documents to request

FY-1986 funding for Low Income Energy Assistance Block Grant.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 7th day of August, 1985, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1640.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting; and 3 absent, pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (c), (d) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by the Papago Council.
