

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL


(Direct Federal Funding for WIC Papago Nutrition Program)


1 WHEREAS, The Papago Tribe has provided preventive health care for women,  
2 infants and children during fiscal year 85; and  
3 WHEREAS, Inter-Tribal Council of Arizona receives funds from the United States  
4 Department of agriculture for programs designed to benefit women,  
5 infants and children; and  
6 WHEREAS, The Papago Tribe, by and through its Nutrition Improvement program has  
7 contracted with the Inter-Tribal Council of Arizona for funds to  
8 operate and fund its women, infants and children (WIC) program; and  
9 WHEREAS, The services provided to eligible clients has been beneficial and  
10 services continue to be necessary to help alleviate nutritional health  
11 risks and improve the health of individuals at risk; and  
12 WHEREAS, The Papago Nutrition Improvement program has prepared an application  
13 for funding in Fiscal year 86;  
14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it hereby approves  
15 the application for funding from the Inter-Tribal Council of Arizona,  
16 to continue to operate and provide services to eligible women, infants  
17 and children; and  
18 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the term of this contract shall commence on October  
19 01, 1985 and end September 30, 1986; and  
20 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Papago Council that Josiah Moore, Chairman,  
21 Francisco Jose, Jr., Vice Chairman or Rosita N. Ruiz, Treasurer, are  
22 hereby authorized to apply for, and negotiate and execute any and all  
23 contracts, amendments and other documents necessary to secure funding  
24 for the WIC program under the Papago Nutrition Improvement program.

26 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 7th  
27 day of August, 1985, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of  
28 1640.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting; and 2 absent, pursuant to the  
29 authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (a), (f) and (h) of Article  
30 V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended,  
31 ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary  
32 of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June  
18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the

1 Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by  
2 the Papago Council.
