

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL
(Water Management Committee's F.Y. 1985 Budget)

RES. NO. 61-85

1 WHEREAS, Public Law 97-293 Title III "Southern Arizona Water Rights Settlement
2 Act of 1982" provides in Section 303 (b) (1) "In order to encourage
3 the Papago Tribe to develop sources of water on the Sells Papago
4 Reservation, the Secretary shall, if so requested by the Tribe, carry
5 out a study to determine the availability and suitability of water
6 resources within the Sells Papago Reservation but outside the Tucson
7 Active Management Area and that part of the Upper Santa Cruz Basin not
8 within that area."; and

9 WHEREAS, Section 309 (b) of Title III of the Act states "The authorized govern-
10 ing body of the Papago Tribe, as trustee for such Tribe, may only spend
11 each year the interest and dividends accruing on the sum held and in-
12 vested pursuant to subsection (a). Such amount may only be used by
13 the Papago Tribe for the subjugation of land, development of water
14 resources, and the construction, operation, maintenance and replacement
15 of related facilities on the Papago Reservation which are not the
16 obligation of the United States under this or any other Act of
17 Congress."; and

18 WHEREAS, Resolution No. 19-85 of the Papago Tribe which was duly enacted by the
19 Papago Tribal Council on January 22, 1985, established a Water Manage-
20 ment Committee to assist the Tribe in fulfilling the purposes and
21 intent of Section 303 (b) (1) of Title III of the Act; and

22 WHEREAS, it is necessary that the Tribal Council establish a budget for the
23 Water Management Committee for the remainder of the fiscal year (March
24 1, 1985 to September 30, 1985); and

25 WHEREAS, the Tribal Water Commissioners have prepared a proposed Water Manage-
26 ment Committee budget for the remainder of this fiscal year, a copy
27 of which is attached hereto and made a part hereof, and


28 WHEREAS, it has been determined that the income accruing to the Trust fund
29 established under Sec. 309 of P.L. 97-293 may be used as a source of
30 funding the Water Management Committee's budget.

31 NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Papago Tribal Council approves the
32 attached budget for the Water Management Committee and directs that

1 Papago P.L. 97-293 Trust-Income accounts established and maintained
2 pursuant to Ordinance No. 03-83 be used to fund said budget.

3 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 7th
4 day of March, 1985, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
5 1158.5 for; 53.5 against; 228.0 not voting; and 0 absent, pursuant to the
6 authority vested in the Council by Section 2 (a), (c), (d), (h) and Section
7 3 (a) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe as
8 amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the
9 Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act
10 of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as of the date
11 of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is subject to
12 review by the Secretary of Interior.


