

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

(Fire Protection for San Lucy District)

Res. No. 618-85

1 WHEREAS, the San Lucy District Council has determined that there is an urgent
2 need to provide the community of San Lucy with fire protection and
3 that such protection can best be secured by the Papago Tribe acting
4 under agreement with the Town of Gila Bend; and



6 WHEREAS, the appropriate officers of the Town of Gila Bend and of the Papago
7 Tribe have negotiated an agreement whereby the Town of Gila Bend
8 will provide fire protection services to the community of San Lucy
9 at a present annual rate of \$75.00 per primary unit; and

10 WHEREAS, the Papago Council approves of the agreement.


11 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby
12 authorize the Chairman and other appropriate officers of the Papago
13 Tribe to execute the agreement with the Town of Gila Bend, and any
14 amendments thereto, and does hereby, authorize the payment of the
15 service fees specified therein pursuant to an amended budget of the
16 Papago Tribe providing therefor.

18 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 7th day
19 of August, 1985, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
20 1385.5 for; 63.0 against; 191.5 not voting; and 01 absent, pursuant to the
21 authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 3 (h) of Article V of the
22 Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe as amended, ratified by the Papago
23 Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on
24 January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.
25 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the Secretary of Interior
26 and is effective as of the date of its enactment by the Papago Council.
