

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL
(Selection of Schuk Toak District lands
to be Serviced by Imported Water)

RES. NO. 620-85

1 WHEREAS, Under the provisions of P.L. 97-293, 96 Stat. 1274, the Schuk Toak
2 District will receive as soon as possible, but not later than October
3 12, 1992, sixteen thousand (16,000) acre feet of imported water
4 delivered through the Central Arizona Project aqueduct; and

5
6 WHEREAS, To utilize 16,000 acre feet of imported water, it is necessary that
7 the Schuk Toak District and the Papago Tribal Council select
8 approximately 4,000 acres of land for an irrigation project; and

9 WHEREAS, To develop an agricultural area of this size it is mandatory that the
10 land to be serviced by the 16,000 acre feet of water be selected at
11 this time so that the necessary archeological, environmental and
12 cultural studies can be accomplished with any preservation or
13 mitigation necessary, and the planning, designing, financing and
14 construction can be completed prior to delivery of the water; and

16 WHEREAS, at a regular meeting of the Schuk Toak District Council on March 16,
17 1985, the District Council discussed the water to be delivered through
18 the Central Arizona Project aqueduct to the District and the selection
19 of land to be serviced by this water; and

20 WHEREAS, the Schuk Toak District Council discussed two areas, the Garcia Strip
21 and the Vaya Strip, for this agricultural development; and

22
23 WHEREAS, the Schuk Toak District Council did pass a resolution selecting and
24 approving lands located in the Garcia Strip for this agricultural
25 development.

26 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Tribal Council that it does hereby
27 approve the use of Tribal lands located in the Garcia Strip, as
28 selected by the Schuk Toak District Council, for the construction of
29 an agricultural development to utilize the imported water to be
30 delivered to the Schuk Toak District as mandated in P.L. 97-293, 96
31 Stat. 1274.


1 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 7th
2 day of August, 1985, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
3 1581.5 for; -0- against; 58.5 not voting; and 01 absent, pursuant to the
4 authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 of Article V and Section 4
5 of Article VIII of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona
6 as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by
7 the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the
8 Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review
9 by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its
10 enactment by the Papago Council.
