1 imported water is constructed on Tribal lands located in the Northwest 2 portion of the San Xavier Reservation as indicated on the map attached 3 hereto and made a part hereof; and 4 WHEREAS, the District Council believes it would be in the best interest of the 5 District, if the location of all roads constructed for the purpose of 6 developing the agricultural area be approved by the District Council 7 8 prior to construction; and 9 WHEREAS, the San Xavier District Council has passed a resolution recommending 10 the use of the Tribal lands located in the Northwest portion of the 11 San Xavier Reservation as set forth on the map attached hereto and 12 made a part hereof, for the construction of an agricultural 13 development to utilize the imported water to be delivered to the San 14 Xavier Reservation as mandated by P.L. 97-293, 96 Stat. 1274. 15 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Tribal Council that it does hereby 16 approve and authorize the use of the Tribal lands located in the 17 18 northwest portion of the San Xavier Reservation as set forth on the 19 map attached hereto and made a part hereof, for the construction of an 20 agricultural development to utilize the imported water to be delivered 21 to the San Xavier District as mandated in P.L. 97-293, 96 Stat. 1274. 22 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that no roads shall be constructed on the San Xavier 23 Reservation in regards to this project without first acquiring the 24 consent and approval of the San Xavier Council. 25 26 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 8th day of August, 1985, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 27 1581.5 for; -O- against; 58.5 not voting; and O absent, pursuant to the

28 authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (c) of Article V and Section 4 of Article VIII of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the 30 Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by the Papago Council.
