

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL
(Selection of San Xavier lands to be
Serviced by Imported Water)

RES. NO. 621-85

- 1 WHEREAS, Under the provisions of P.L. 97-293, 96 Stat. 1274, the San Xavier
2 District will receive as soon as possible, but not later than October
3 12, 1992, fifty thousand (50,000) acre feet of imported water
4 delivered through the Central Arizona Project aqueduct; and
5
6 WHEREAS, To utilize 50,000 acre feet of imported water, it is necessary that
7 the District and the Tribal Council select approximately 12,000 acres
8 of land for an irrigation project; and
9
10 WHEREAS, To develop an agricultural area of this size it is mandatory that the
11 land to be serviced by the 50,000 acre feet of water be selected at
12 this time so that the necessary archeological, environmental and
13 cultural studies can be accomplished with any preservation or
14 mitigation necessary, and the planning, designing, financing and
15 construction can be completed prior to delivery of the water; and
16
17 WHEREAS, After several meetings with the District Council and numerous public
18 meetings at San Xavier on the water settlement, Central Arizona
19 Project water allocations, Central Arizona Project, the alignment of
20 the Aqueduct through the District, three public hearings were held at
21 San Xavier on June 29, 1985, July 20, 1985 and July 23, 1985, in
22 regards to the selection of land to be serviced by water delivered
23 through the Central Arizona Project aqueduct; and

25 WHEREAS, the District gave notice of the three public hearings to all district
26 members including all allottees of the San Xavier District; and

28 WHEREAS, After full consideration of all of the data, maps, comparison studies,
29 cost analysis, advantages and disadvantages and all statements,
30 concerns and comments made by the members attending the public
31 hearings, the District Council believes it would be in the best
32 interest of the San Xavier District, the allottees and the Papago
Tribe if the agricultural development that will be served by the

1 imported water is constructed on Tribal lands located in the Northwest
2 portion of the San Xavier Reservation as indicated on the map attached
3 hereto and made a part hereof; and

4 WHEREAS, the District Council believes it would be in the best interest of the
5 District, if the location of all roads constructed for the purpose of
6 developing the agricultural area be approved by the District Council
7 prior to construction; and

8 WHEREAS, the San Xavier District Council has passed a resolution recommending
9 the use of the Tribal lands located in the Northwest portion of the
10 San Xavier Reservation as set forth on the map attached hereto and
11 made a part hereof, for the construction of an agricultural
12 development to utilize the imported water to be delivered to the San
13 Xavier Reservation as mandated by P.L. 97-293, 96 Stat. 1274.


14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Tribal Council that it does hereby
15 approve and authorize the use of the Tribal lands located in the
16 northwest portion of the San Xavier Reservation as set forth on the
17 map attached hereto and made a part hereof, for the construction of an
18 agricultural development to utilize the imported water to be delivered
19 to the San Xavier District as mandated in P.L. 97-293, 96 Stat. 1274.

20 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that no roads shall be constructed on the San Xavier
21 Reservation in regards to this project without first acquiring the
22 consent and approval of the San Xavier Council.

23 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 8th
24 day of August, 1985, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
25 1581.5 for; -0- against; 58.5 not voting; and 0 absent, pursuant to the
26 authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (c) of Article V and Section
27 4 of Article VIII of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona
28 as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by
29 the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the
30 Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review
31 by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its
32 enactment by the Papago Council.
