

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

(Modification of Title II - Indian Child Welfare Grant)

RES. NO. 624-85

1 WHEREAS, The Papago Human Service has the primary responsibility to provide
2 for the care, treatment and welfare of children;

3 WHEREAS, Title II of the Indian Child Welfare Act of 1978 provides funds for
4 development of Child Welfare Programs under specified terms and
5 conditions; and

7 WHEREAS, The Papago Human Service Department in conjunction with Baboquivari
8 High School is capable of developing and implementing a culturally
9 relevant program specifically geared toward teenage single mothers;


11 WHEREAS, There is a need for a program which will address both the educational
12 and parenting needs of the teenage mothers.

14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby
15 approve to modify the application of the Papago Human Services for
16 Title II funds to develop and implement a culturally relevant program
17 specifically geared toward teenage single mothers which will decrease
18 the incidents of child abuse and neglect.

19 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Josiah Moore, Chairman; Francisco Jose, Vice
20 Chairman or Rosita N. Ruiz, Treasurer of the Papago Council are here-
21 by authorized to negotiate and execute all necessary documents to
22 request for funding.

24 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 8th
25 day of August, 1985, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
26 751.0 for; 382.0 against; 507.0 not voting; and 2 absent, pursuant to the
27 authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (a), (f) and (h) of Article
28 V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended,
29 ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary
of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June
18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the
Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by
the Papago Council.
