

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

(P.L. 93-638 - Sells Reservation Water Study)

RES. NO. 625-85

1 WHEREAS, Section 303 (b) (1) of Title III of P.L. 97-293, the Southern  
2 Arizona Water Rights Settlement Act of 1982 authorized and directed  
3 that a study be done to determine the availability and suitability  
4 of Water Resources within the Sells Papago Reservation; and

5  
6 WHEREAS, the Congress has appropriated \$1,000,000.00 for the study of water  
7 Resources within the Sells Papago Reservation; and

8 WHEREAS, 25 CFR Section 271 of the Federal Regulation Provides the Mechanism  
9 for Tribes to enter into P.L. 93-638 contracts; and

10 WHEREAS, the Papago Tribal Council does desire to contract for the Sells  
11 Reservation water resources study; and

12 WHEREAS, the Papago Tribal Council has reviewed and approved the Water  
13 Resources Study Phase I in the amount of \$375,513.



15 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Papago Council does hereby  
16 authorize the Papago Tribe to enter into a multi-year contract with  
17 the Bureau of Indian Affairs for the study of water resources within  
18 the Sells Papago Reservation Pursuant to 25 CFR 271.52. The  
19 Contract term shall commence on October 1, 1985 and end on September  
20 30, 1988.

21 BE IT FURTHER RESOVLED that Josiah Moore Chairman, Francisco Jose Jr. Vice  
22 Chairman or Rosita Ruiz Treasurer of the Papago Council is hereby  
23 authorized to negotiate and execute this contract and any amendments  
24 thereto for the duration of the contract.

26 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 8th  
27 day of August, 1985, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of  
28 1374.0 for; 117.0 against; 64.0 not voting; and 02 absent, pursuant to the  
29 authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (a) and (h) of Article V of  
30 the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended, ratified  
31 by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the  
Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934  
(48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the Secretary of  
the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by the Papago  
Council.
