

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL
(Tribal Chairman will not participate in District
Chairman's Meetings)

RES. NO. 656-85

1 WHEREAS, Concerns of the District Chairman's Meetings held with each of the
2 eleven Districts were brought to the attention of Josiah Moore,
3 Chairman of the Papago Tribe; and



5 WHEREAS, In the impression of the Papago Council, information presented at
6 Tribal Council Meetings and at District Chairman's Meeting created a
7 state of confusion and in communications among District Councils; and

8 WHEREAS, The Papago Council feels that it is in the best interest of the Papago
9 Tribe that the District Chairman's Meetings continue under the di-
10 rection and leadership of a district Chairman's organization.

11 NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it hereby directs that
12 Josiah Moore, Chairman of the Papago Tribe to participate in the
13 District Chairman's Meetings, upon invitation by the District
14 Chairman's organization to make presentations regarding pertinent
15 information related to the general well being of the Papago Tribe.

17 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 12th
18 day of August, 1985, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote
19 of 1235.5 for; -0- against; 404.5 not voting; and 02 absent, pursuant to the
20 authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2(f) of Article V of the
21 Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended, ratified
22 by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of
the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18,
1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the Secretary
of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by the Papago
Council.
