## RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL (Chuichu Area Water Settlement Bill)

WHEREAS, non-Indian surface water diversion and ground water pumping near or bordering the Chuichu Area of the Sif Oidak
District has resulted in the depletion of the ground
water, the compaction and periodic flooding of land, all
in derogation and to the detriment of the rights of the
Papago Tribe and its members; and

WHEREAS, over the past three decades, the Tribe has been forced to abandon its irrigated agricultural enterprises in the Chuichu Area as well as joint Tribal-Federal plans to develop fifteen thousand acres of land in that area as a result of the decline in and final depletion of the water table; and

WHEREAS, the water rights claims of the Papago Tribe with respect to the Chuichu Area of the Sif Oidak District are the subject of prospective lawsuits against the United States; and

WHEREAS, the Papago Tribal Council did appoint a water commission consisting of, among others, a member residing within the Chuichu Area of the Sif Oidak District, in order to review and study all available material and data relative to the water basins near and under the Chuichu Area of the Sif Oidak District, and to negotiate and develop a legislative settlement of the water rights claims of this area of the District, and to conduct public hearings in the District; and

WHEREAS, a draft of a proposed Congressional bill to settle the tribal water rights claims regarding the Chuichu Area of the Sif Oidak District has been developed and studied by the Papago Water Commission and a public hearing was held on this settlement bill in the Sif Oidak District on

NO. 661-85 (Chuichu Area Water Settlement Bill) Page Two (2) August 20, 1985; and WHEREAS, on the 27th day of August , 1985, the Sif Oidak District Council did enact a resolution approving settlement of the water rights claims of the Papago Tribe regarding the Chuichu Area of the Sif Oidak District substantially in conformity with the terms and conditions of the proposed Congressional bill. NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Tribal Council that it does hereby approve settlement of the Tribal Water rights claims regarding the Chuichu Area of the Sif Oidak District substantially in conformity with the terms and conditions of the proposed Congressional bill attached hereto and made a part hereof. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman of the Papago Tribe, the members of the Water Commission, the attorneys, lobbyist and advisors do all things necessary to have the Congressional bill introduced and processed through the U.S. House and Senate and enacted into law. 19 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the <u>10th</u> day of <u>September</u>, 1985, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of <u>1,518.5</u> for; <u>-0-</u> against; <u>121.5</u> not voting; and <u>01</u> absent, pursuant not voting; and 01 absent, pursuant to 21 the authority vested in the Council by Sections 2(a), (d), (e) and (f) and Section 3(h) of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the Secretary of Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by the Papago Council. THE PAPAGO COUNCIL USCO W.
