1	WHEREAS,	on September 11, 1985, the Council did enact a resolution wherein the
2		Council did approve Noranda Exploration, Inc., request to amend its
3		mining lease (Contract No. H50C84201257) with the Tribe where by the
4		Tribe will receive \$180,000.00 less in mining income for the period
5		commencing October 1, 1985 through September 30, 1986; and
7	WHEREAS,	in 1982, the Council enacted Ordinance No. 13-82 wherein it directed
8	-	that all mining income be allocated fifty-five percent (55%) to the
9		Papago Tribe, three percent (3%) to Sif Oidak District, and the
10		balance of forty-two percent (42%) to the various districts; and
1	WHEREAS,	the Council believes it would be in the best interest of the Tribe if
12		this additional reduction of \$180,000.00 of mining income be deducted
3		from the mining royalties allocated for deposit to the general account
14		of the Papago Tribe.

18		for the period commencing October 1, 1985 through September 30, 1986
19		be deducted from the mining income allocated for deposit to the
20	100	general account of the Papago Tribe under the provisions of Section 1

	The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 11th day	

of September, 1985, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 25 1161.5 for; 478.5 against; -0- not voting; and 01 absent, pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (h) and (m) and Section 3 26 (h) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by the Papago Council.
