RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL


(TO ADJUST SECRETARY I TO III AND
INCREASE LINE ITEM-MILEAGE)

RES. NO. 665-85

1 WHEREAS, on the 11th day of September, 1985 the Budget & Finance Committee
2 presented all proposed tribal budgets to the Tribal Council; and
3 WHEREAS, the Hiatit O'odham Program is a newly established program under the
4 tribal budgets; and
5 WHEREAS, the Council has reviewed the proposed budget for the Hiatit O'odham
6 Program; and
7 WHEREAS, the Council feels it would be in the best interest of the Hiatit
8 O'odham Program to hire a Secretary III instead of a Secretary I as
9 stated in the proposed budget, being that this is a newly established
10 office and to be able to provide for the smooth operation of the
11 program a secretary with previous experience and excellent qualifica-
12 tions is needed; and
13 WHEREAS, the Hiatit O'odham Program has estimated the personnel to be traveling
14 approximately 610 miles per month using their personal vehicles,
15 instead of the estimated 315 miles per month as recommended by the
16 Budget and Finance Committee.
17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Tribal Council that it does hereby
18 amend the Hiatit O'odham Program budget for FY 1986, specifically
19 changing the Secretary I position to a Secretary III and increasing
20 line item-Mileage from \$757.00 to \$1,464.00, bringing the grand total
21 for the program to \$62,225.40.

22 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 11th
23 day of September, 1985, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a
24 vote of 217.0 for; 1306.0 against; 117.0 not voting; and -0- absent, pursuant
25 to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (f) of Article
26 V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended,
27 ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary
of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June
18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the
Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment
by the Papago Council.
