

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL


(Accepting Budget & Finance Recommendation  
of the T.E.R.O. Budget for \$76,440.00)


1 WHEREAS, on the 11th day of September, 1985 the Budget and Finance Committee  
2 presented all proposed tribal budgets for FY 1986 to the Papago  
3 Council; and  
4 WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is aware of the two (2) budgets submitted by the  
5 Tribal Employment Rights Office (T.E.R.O.), the first budget in the  
6 amount of \$76,440.00 and the second budget in the amount of \$93,668.00  
7 and  
8 WHEREAS, it has been recommended by the Budget and Finance Committee to  
9 accept the first proposed budget in the amount of \$76,440.00.  
10 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Tribal Council that it does hereby  
11 accept the recommendation of the Budget and Finance Committee to  
12 accept the Tribal Employment Rights Office (T.E.R.O.) FY 1986 budget  
13 in the amount of \$76,440.00.

14 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 11th  
15 day of September, 1985, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a  
16 vote of 1480.5 for; 42.5 against; 117.0 not voting; and -0- absent, pursuant  
17 to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (f) of Article  
18 V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended,  
19 ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary  
of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June  
18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the  
Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment  
by the Papago Council.
