

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

(General Counsel Contract 1985-1987)

RES NO. 669-85

1 WHEREAS, The Papago Tribe has retained the law firm of Strickland and Altaffer  
2 under a General Counsel Contract dated September 8, 1983, (Symbol  
3 H50C1420-Contract No.3752); and  
4

5 WHEREAS, said General Counsel Contract was amended by Amendment to General  
6 Counsel Contract dated August 22, 1984, pursuant to Resolution No.  
7 241-84 of the Papago Council; and

8 WHEREAS, said General Counsel Contract, as amended, expires on the 24th day of  
9 September, 1985, and the law firm of Strickland and Altaffer has  
10 performed its duties under said contract proficiently and  
11 competently; and

13 WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Papago Tribe to retain the law firm of  
14 Strickland and Altaffer, P.C. as general counsel for an additional  
15 two-year period.


16 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that the law firm of  
17 Strickland and Altaffer, P.C. be employed by the attached General  
18 Counsel Contract, and any amendments or extension thereof, and the  
19 Chairman and Secretary of the Papago Council are hereby authorized  
20 and directed to execute said Contract for and on the behalf of the  
21 Papago Tribe.

23 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 12th  
24 day of September, 1985, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote  
25 of 1,460.0 for; 180.0 against; -0- not voting; and -0- absent, pursuant to  
26 the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2(b) and Section 3(a) and  
27 (h) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona  
28 as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by  
the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the  
Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution effective as of the date  
of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is subject to  
review by the Secretary of the Interior.


