

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

(Acceptance of the Papago Skill Center Program  
P.L. 93-638 FY-1985 Budget/Contract)

RES. NO. 677-85

1 WHEREAS, Congress has appropriated \$143,000.00 in 1985 for the training of  
2 Papagos in construction trades at the Papago Skill Center; and

3 WHEREAS, 25 CFR Part 271 provides the Papago Tribe with the mechanism to  
4 contract for Bureau programs; and

5 WHEREAS, The Papago Tribal Council does desire to contract for provisions of  
6 these services during FY 1985; and

7 WHEREAS, the Papago Tribal Council has reviewed and approved the Papago Skill  
8 Center Program contract.

10 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does authorize  
11 and request the Bureau of Indian Affairs to contract with the Papago  
12 Tribe under P.L. 93-638 regulations and procedures for the provision  
13 of services titled Papago Skill Center.  
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15 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the term of this contract shall commence on August  
16 01, 1985 and end July 31, 1986.


17 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Papago Tribe will not fund or operate programs  
18 from which contracts are requested herewith which have not been  
19 negotiated and executed by the Bureau of Indian Affairs prior to the  
20 award.

21 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Josiah Moore, Chairman; Francisco Jose, Jr., Vice  
22 Chairman or Rosita Ruiz, Treasurer of the Papago Council is hereby  
23 authorized to negotiate and execute these contracts and any amendments  
24 thereto for the duration of the contracts.  
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26 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 12th day  
27 of September, 1985, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of  
28 1640.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting; and 01 absent, pursuant to the  
29 authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (a), (f) and (h) of Article  
30 V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended,  
31 ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary  
32 of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June  
18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the  
Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by  
the Papago Council.
