10	the range of activities that may be assisted, and other important					
11	program requirements, and solicited their views and participation;					
12	followed traditional Tribal means of citizen involvement that included					
13	holding at least one adequately publicized meeting of the Tribal					
14	Council at a time and location convenient to Tribal citizens which					
15	provided them with adequate opportunity to articulate needs, express					
16	preferences about proposal community development and housing activities,					
17	assist in the selection of priorities and otherwise participate in the					
18	development of the application; considered any comments or views					
19	expressed by Tribal members and has modified the application accordingly					
20	made the modified application available to Tribal members for review					
21	and comments.

25	tary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 948). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the					
26	Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by the Papago Council.
