

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

(FY 85 Housing Improvement Program)

RES. NO. 679-85

1 WHEREAS, There is a continuing need for the construction of new homes on the
2 Papago Reservation; and

3 WHEREAS, FY'85 funding is available through the Bureau of Indian Affairs
4 Housing Improvement Program for the construction of new homes; and

5
6 WHEREAS, 25 CFR Section 271 of the Federal Regulations provides the mechanism
7 for Indian Tribes to enter into P.L. 93-638 contracts with the Bureau
8 of Indian Affairs; and

9 WHEREAS, The Papago Tribal Council desires to contract for the Housing
10 Improvement Program; and

11 WHEREAS, The Papago Tribal Council has reviewed and approved the FY'85 Housing
12 Improvement Program for the construction of nine (9) homes in the
13 amount of \$350,937.00.


15 NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Papago Council does hereby authorize the
16 Papago Tribe to enter into a one year contract with the Bureau of
17 Indian Affairs for the construction of new homes under the Housing
18 Improvement Program. The contract term shall commence on September
19 15, 1985 and end on September 14, 1986.

20 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Josiah Moore, Chairman, Francisco Jose, Jr., Vice
21 Chairman or Rosita Ruiz, Treasurer, of the Papago Council is hereby
22 authorized to negotiate and execute these contracts and any amendments
23 thereto for the duration of the contracts.

25 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 12th day
26 of September, 1985, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
27 1228.0 for; 327.0 against; 85.0 not voting; and 02 absent, pursuant to the
28 authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (a) and (h) of Article V of
29 the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended, ratified
30 by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the
Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934
(48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the Secretary of
the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by the Papago
Council.
