RES. NO. 680-85


1 WHEREAS, the Papago Tribe is presently operating Juvenile Delinquency
2 Prevention Services under an agreement with United Way of Tucson; and
3 WHEREAS, such services for the youth have been successful and beneficial; and
4 WHEREAS, the Papago Council does desire to enter into an agreement for services
5 during FY'86.

7 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does support and
8 authorize the Papago Tribe to enter into an agreement with United Way
9 of Tucson for Juvenile Delinquency Prevention Services.


10 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Josiah Moore, Chairman, Francisco Jose, Jr., Vice
11 Chairman, Rosita Ruiz, Treasurer of the Papago Council are hereby
12 authorized to negotiate and execute the agreement and any amendments
13 thereto for the duration of the agreement.

15 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 12th day
16 of September, 1985, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
17 1326.0 for; -0- against; 314.0 not voting; and 01 absent, pursuant to the
18 authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (a) and (h) of Article V of
19 the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended, ratified
20 by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the
Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934
(48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the Secretary of
the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by the Papago
Council.
