15	authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (f) and (h) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended, ratified						
16	by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the						
17	Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the Secretary of						
18	the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by the Papago Council.
