

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL
(Authorizing PTUA to handle Fiscal Monies)

RES. NO. 68-85

1 WHEREAS, The Papago Council did by Resolution 8-70 grant to PTUA in its Plan
2 of Operation full power and authority to have the custody, management,
3 operation, and maintenance of all utilities and utility facilities on
4 the Papago Reservation; and gave PTUA authority to take any and all
5 usual, necessary and convenient actions incidental thereto including,
6 should it be deemed advisable or desirable, the borrowing of funds,
7 and the making of contracts or commitments necessary to the function-
8 ing of the organization; and

9 WHEREAS, PTUA was further authorized and directed by Resolution 200-83, on be-
10 half of PTUA and the Papago Tribe, to seek and file applications for
11 loans and grants for the purpose of acquiring, developing, extending
12 and financing telephone facilities and services on the Papago
13 Reservation; and


14 WHEREAS, The Board of Directors of PTUA has, by Resolution 2-85 authorized its
15 General Manager to file an application for a HUD-CDBG grant; and

16 WHEREAS, it would be in the best interest of all parties concerned that, if
17 funding becomes available, all funds be sub-contracted to PTUA.

18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Papago Council does hereby authorize
19 PTUA to negotiate directly for HUD-CDBG grant monies and, if and
20 when funds become available, to sub-contract therefore.

21 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 8th
22 day of March, 1985, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
23 1031.0 for; 409.0 against; -0- not voting; and 2 absent, pursuant to
24 the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (a) and (f) of Article
25 V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended,
26 ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary
of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June
18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the
Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by
the Papago Council.
