

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

(FY'82 Ak Chin Appropriation)

RES. NO. 688-85

1 WHEREAS, the Papago Tribe has learned of excess Bureau of Indian Affairs funds,
2 appropriated during FY'82, relating to water projects for the Ak Chin
3 Reservation; and

4 WHEREAS, these excess funds, totalling approximately \$400,000.00 is in the
5 process of being reprogrammed to other Bureau or federal project uses
6 at the request of the Bureau of Indian Affairs, Phoenix Area Office;
7 and

8 WHEREAS, the Papago Tribe believes it is eligible to request such funds and
9 has advised the Phoenix Area Office of projects found to be within
10 the allowed uses for the excess funds; and

11 WHEREAS, These projects have been designated as priority projects and the
12 Papago Council has directed and authorized the appropriate Bureau and
13 Tribal officials to secure funding for such projects; and

14 WHEREAS, The Bureau of Indian Affairs is obligated to consider the request
15 before a decision to reprogram is made to determine whether or not
16 the Papago Tribe's list of projects are eligible for funding out of
17 the \$400,000.00.


18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby request
19 the Bureau of Indian Affairs to review and consider the attached list
20 of proposed projects for funding out of the FY'82 Ak Chin appropriation
21 before any reprogramming decision is made and to make every reasonable
22 effort to fund such projects in accordance with applicable regulations.

23 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Josiah Moore, Chairman, Francisco Jose, Jr., Vice
24 Chairman or Rosita Ruiz, Treasurer, of the Papago Council is hereby
25 authorized to negotiate and execute these contracts and any amendments
26 thereto for the duration of the contracts.

27 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 13th
28 day of September, 1985, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote
29 of 1,640.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting and -0- absent, pursuant to the
30 authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (a), (d) and (h) of Article
31 V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended,
32 ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by the Papago Council.


