

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

(Accepting Papago Psychological Service's Contract)

RES. NO. 69-85

1 WHEREAS, The Papago Tribe of Arizona is presently operating the following  
2 program under FY 84 P.L. 93-638 service contract with the Public Health,  
3 Indian Health Service:

4 Papago Psychological Service

5 WHEREAS, Such Tribal operations have been successful and beneficial to the  
6 Papago Tribe and its people; and

7 WHEREAS, 25 CFR Sec. 371.20 of the Federal Regulations require that all pro-  
8 posals to recontract under P.L. 93-638 be submitted to the Tribal  
9 Council for approval at least 120 days prior to the contract termi-  
10 nation; and

11 WHEREAS, The Papago Council does desire to recontract for provision of these  
12 services during FY 86.

13 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Tribal Council that it does  
14 authorize and request the Public Health, Indian Health Service to  
15 contract with the Papago Tribe under P.L. 93-638 regulations and  
16 procedures for the provision of services titled:

17 249-82-0008 Papago Psychological Services.

18 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the duration of this contract shall be from October  
19 01, 1985 through September 30, 1986, unless extended by mutual a-  
20 greement of both parties.

21 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that in the event that this contract does not become  
22 effective on October 01, 1985, continuation of this program will be  
23 based on an extension of the existing 1984 contract until such time  
24 that the FY 86 contract becomes effective.


25 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Papago Tribe will not fund or operate a program  
26 for which a contract is requested herewith and that has not been  
27 negotiated and executed by the Indian Health Service prior to the  
28 start of the funding year.

29 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Josiah Moore, Chairman, or in his absence, Francisco  
30 Jose, Jr., Vice-Chairman or Rosita N. Ruiz, Treasurer, is hereby  
31 authorized to negotiate and execute this contract.

32 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 8th

1 day of March, 1985, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of  
2 1,202.5 for; -0- against; 237.5 not voting; and 03 absent, pursuant to the  
3 authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (a) and (h) of Article V of  
4 the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended, ratified  
5 by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the  
Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934  
(48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the Secretary of  
the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by the Papago  
Council.
