

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL


(O'Odham Detox Inc.)


1 WHEREAS, The Papago Council endorsed and supported the Papago Detox (O'Odham
2 Detox Inc.) on the 3rd day of November, 1983;
3 WHEREAS, The Papago Detox Program has developed at this point in time, but has
4 need for a trailer;
5 WHEREAS, Indian Health Service (IHS) has agreed to furnish a trailer to the
6 Papago Tribe, upon request from the Tribe;
7 WHEREAS, The trailer will be used for Administrative purposes and other func-
8 tions necessary to carry out day to day Detox Service,
9 WHEREAS, The Papago Detox will agree with all terms concerning the use of the
10 trailer.
11 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby request
12 and direct the IHS to furnish a trailer for use by the Papago Detox
13 Program, in order that it may achieve its objectives, and implement
14 Reservation Detox Service.

15 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 8th
16 day of March, 1985, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
17 1249.5 for; -0- against; 190.5 not voting; and 2 absent, pursuant to
18 the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (a) and (h) of Article
19 V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended,
20 ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary
of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June
18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the
Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by
the Papago Council.
