

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

(Accepting of E.K. Enterprise's Bid)

RES. NO. 74-85

1 WHEREAS, The Papago Council did authorize and direct the Executive Office to
2 prepare a bidding process and procedure for the completion of eleven
3 (11) HIP homes, such bidding to be extended to all O'Odham Contractors;

4 WHEREAS, The Papago Council did review the process established and is satisfied
5 that all O'Odham Contractors were considered and notified of the
6 projects in a fair manner;

7 WHEREAS, Deadlines for bids was established and all potential bidders were duly
8 notified;

9 WHEREAS, E.K. LANDSCAPING & BUILDING COMPANY, a sole bidder, submitted a bid
10 within the time frames and conditions established by the Executive
11 Office;


12 WHEREAS, The Papago Council has reviewed the bid submitted by E.K. LANDSCAPING
13 & BUILDING CO. and finds the bid acceptable except that a review by
14 the Executive Office reveals a savings in certain areas bringing the
15 bid down to a new dollar amount;

16 WHEREAS, E.K. LANDSCAPING & BUILDING COMPANY has considered the savings estimates
17 and is agreeable to the lower bid quote;

18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby accept
19 the bid of E.K. LANDSCAPING & BUILDING COMPANY to complete eleven (11)
20 HIP homes on the condition that the original bid figure of \$451,115.12
21 is reduced to \$369,100 based on identified savings not taken into
22 consideration by E.K. LANDSCAPING & BUILDING COMPANY.

23 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 11th
24 day of March, 1985, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
25 1353.5 for; 25.5 against; 61.0 not voting and -0- absent, pursuant to the
26 authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (f) of Article V of the
27 Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended, ratified by
28 the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the
29 Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934
30 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the Secretary of
31 the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by the Papago
32 Council.
