

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL
(Policies & Procedures Committee Appointment)


1 WHEREAS, The Papago Council has the authority to establish such committee as
2 it believes will enhance the work of the Council;
3 WHEREAS, The Papago Council has the authority to proscribe and prescribe what
4 the duties of the committee members will be;
5 WHEREAS, The Papago Council is desirous of establishing uniform and consistent
6 policy and procedures for its standing committee and believes that an
7 Ad Hoc Committe of five members specifically authorized to carry out
8 this task is needed;
9 NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby establish
10 a Policy & Procedure Committee of five members to carry out the tasks
11 to be defined by Council.

12 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the following have been appointed to the Policies
13 & Procedures Committee:

19 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 11th
20 day of March, 1985, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
21 1079.5 for; 308.0 against; 52.5 not voting; and -0- absent, pursuant to
22 the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (e) (f) and (h) of
23 Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as
24 amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by
the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the
Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review
by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enact-
ment by the Papago Council.
