

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL  
(Calling for Secretarial Election on proposed Constitution)

RESO. NO. 774-85

1 WHEREAS, The Papago Council did, by Resolution No. 147-84, on July 12, 1984,  
2 propose a new constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation for submission  
3 to and ratification by the qualified voters of the Papago Tribe voting  
4 at a special election called for that purpose by the Secretary of the  
5 Interior in accordance with the provisions of Article IX of the  
6 Constitution, if adopted and approved, will supersede the current  
7 Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe; and  
8

9 WHEREAS, The Council did refer the proposed Constitution of the Tohono O'odham  
10 Nation for review by the Secretary of the Interior with the request  
11 that he authorize the calling of a Secretarial election thereon in  
12 accordance with the provisions of 25 C.F.R. Part 81; and

14 WHEREAS, John W. Fritz, Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs  
15 (Operations), did by letter dated August 26, 1985, suggest certain  
16 modifications to the proposed Constitution and did authorize the  
17 Superintendent of the Papago Agency to call and conduct a Secretarial  
18 election in accordance with the provisions of 25 C.F.R. Part 81, pro-  
19 vided the Papago Council did determine that the suggested modifi-  
20 cations were acceptable; and  
21

22 WHEREAS, The Council has reviewed the suggested modifications and the justifi-  
23 cations therefor and has determined that the modifications are  
24 acceptable and that the modified version of the proposed Constitution  
25 should be submitted to the qualified voters of the Papago Tribe at a  
26 Secretarial election to be held on Saturday, the 18th day of January,  
27 1986; and

29 WHEREAS, 25 C.F.R. S 81.8 requires the creation of an election board consisting  
30 of the Superintendent of the Papago Agency as officer in charge and  
31 chairman, and of at least two representatives of the Papago Council,  
32 or of an authorized representative committee, to conduct the election.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby



approve the proposed Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, as modified by the Department of the Interior, and does hereby set the Secretarial election thereon for Saturday, the 18th day of January, 1986.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the members of the Constitution Committee are hereby designated and appointed as the authorized representative committee of this Council on the election board charged with the conduct of the election.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 18th day of September, 1985, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1391.0 for; 180.0 against; 69.0 not voting; and -0- absent, pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2(a), (e) and (f) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by the Papago Council.
