

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

(Authorizing the Law & Order Committee to Proceed with Contracting with N.I.J.C. for Tribal Court Evaluation)

RES. NO. 778-85

1 WHEREAS, The Papago Council did appoint a Law & Order Committee for the purpose  
2 of as follows:

- 3 (a) to adopt and recommend a Committee budget to the Papago Council;  
4 (b) to adopt, formulate, and amend rules, regulations and guidelines  
5 necessary to carry out its business;  
6 (c) to appoint a Committee chairperson and secretary, and such other  
7 officers as may be appropriate;  
8 (d) to review the Law and Order Code and the Ordinances and Reso-  
9 lutions of the Papago Council constituting the Civil and Criminal  
10 laws of the Papago Tribe, and their effects upon the Papago Tribe  
11 and its members, and upon the Judicial Departments of the Papago  
12 Tribe, and to make recommendations to the Papago Council for re-  
13 visions and amendments of, or additions to the Law and Order Code  
14 constitution the civil and criminal laws of the Papago Tribe;  
15 (e) to assist the Judicial Departments of the Papago Tribe in the  
16 developments of standards, rules and procedures within their  
17 respective jurisdictions for the effective administration of  
18 justice on the Papago Reservation;  
19 (f) to assist the Judicial Departments of the Papago Tribe and  
20 other tribal and governmental organizations and enterprises  
21 involved with the justice system on the Papago Reservation by  
22 supporting and assisting in the implementation and funding  
23 of innovative tribal justice programs;  
24 (g) to interview applicants for the positions of judges and De-  
25 partment heads of the Judicial Departments of the Papago Tribe  
26 and to make recommendations, respectively, to the Papago Council  
27 and the Personnel Officer for appointments to such positions;  
28 (h) to make recommendations and advise the Papago Council on all  
29 matters relating to the operation of the Judicial Departments of  
30 the Papago Tribe.

31 WHEREAS, The Law & Order Committee is requesting the authority to proceed to  
32 contract with the National Indian Justice Center for an evaluation  
on the Tribal Court System to implement their directive by Council.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Council authorizes the contract  
between the Tribe and the National Indian Justice Center.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 18th  
day of September, 1985, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote  
of 1314.5 for; -0- against; 325.5 not voting; and -0- absent, pursuant to the  
authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (a), (f), (h) and 3 (b) of  
Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as  
amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the


