

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

(Intergovernmental Food Service Agreement)
(Early Childhood Head Start/Home Start)

RES. NO. 780-85

1 WHEREAS, the Child Care Food Program of the State of Arizona has funded
2 breakfast, lunch and snacks of the Papago Early Childhood Head Start
3 Program by means of an Intergovernmental Food Service Agreement
4 between the Papago Tribe and the State of Arizona; and

6 WHEREAS, the Papago Early Childhood Head Start Program has recommended renewal
7 of said agreement, effective October 1, 1985; and


8 WHEREAS, the Papago Council has reviewed the recommendation and supports the
9 Early Childhood Head Start Program continuance of the Child Care Food
10 Program.

11 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby
12 approve the renewal of the application implementing the Child Care
13 Food Program from October 1, 1985 through September 30, 1986.


15 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Papago Council that Josiah Moore, Chairman,
16 Francisco Jose, Vice-Chairman or Rosita N. Ruiz, Treasurer of the
17 Papago Council are authorized to execute the Intergovernmental Food
18 Service Agreement, or any amendments thereto.

19 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 9th day
20 of October, 1985, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
21 1519.5 for; -0- against; 120.5 not voting; and 01 absent, pursuant to the
22 authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (a) and (h) of Article V of
23 the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended, ratified
24 by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the
25 Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934
(48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the Secretary of
26 the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by the Papago
27 Council.
