WHEREAS,	the Papago Council did by Resolution No. 368-85 authorize and direct
	the Papago Tribal Utility Authority ("PTUA") to acquire and to
	negotiate with Tucson Electric Power Company ("TEP") for the purchase
	of TEP's electrical distribution facilities on the San Xavier
	Reservation; and

WHEREAS, TEP has, by letter dated August 15, 1985, requested the simultaneous negotiation or renegotiation of two other matters, namely (1) of the terms of the Consent to Grant of Easement for Right-of-Way and Agreement between the Papago Tribe and TEP dated June 25, 1974, and (2) of the purchase of a new right-of-way easement, 200 feet in width, for a proposed 345 KV transmission line, paralleling the existing Trico Electric Coop line, across the Garcia Strip of the Schuk Toak District; and

WHEREAS, the Papago Council has determined that any such negotiations be best undertaken by the PTUA, acting in consultation and cooperation with all affected districts and agencies of the Papago Tribe.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby authorize and direct PTUA to negotiate and arrange for the purchase of TEP's electrical distribution facilities on the San Xavier Reservation, and does hereby further authorize and direct that the PTUA undertake negotiations on behalf of the Papago Tribe of the foregoing two matters requested by TEP.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the foregoing negotiations be undertaken and managed by the PTUA in consultation and cooperation with all affected districts and agencies of the Papago Tribe, and that PTUA charge its reasonable costs incurred in its negotiations on behalf of the Tribe of the foregoing two matters requested by TEP to the Papago Tribe.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 9th day of October, 1985, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of

1640.0 for; _O_ against; _O_ not voting; and O2 absent, pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (a) and (f) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by the Papago Council.
