

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

(Requesting Titles to Indian Health Service Trailers)

RES. NO. 786-85

1 WHEREAS, The Papago Council did by Resolution Number 71-85 request the Indian
2 Health Service (I.H.S.) to convey to the Papago Tribe titles to two
3 unidentified trailers situated on the Papago Reservation which is no
4 longer required by the Indian Health Service for original purpose use
5 by the tribe in the Papago Detox Program; and

7 WHEREAS, The Indian Health Service has advised the Tribe that there are
8 presently two trailers, and a duplex quarters located on the
9 reservation which are no longer required by the Indian Health Service
10 namely:


11 Building No. 612, 12 x 56', 2 Bedroom house trailer,
12 Building No. 622, 10 x 50', office trailer, and
13 Building No. 546, 2550 sq. ft. duplex quarters, two apartments; and

14 WHEREAS, The Papago Tribe has a great need for such trailers.


15 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby amend
16 Resolution No. 71-85 and request the Indian Health Service to convey
17 title to the foregoing trailers to the Papago Tribe in accordance with
18 the provisions of 25 U.S.C. 443a.

19 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 9th day
20 of October, 1985, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
21 1640.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting; and 01 absent, pursuant to the
22 authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (a) of Article V of the
23 Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended, ratified by
24 the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the
25 Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934
(48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the Secretary of
26 the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by the Papago
27 Council.
