

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL
(Revenue Sharing-Equal Distribution to each of the Eleven Districts)
(\$36,930.00 Reserved for Administration)

RES. NO. 788-85

1 WHEREAS, The Revenue Sharing Act, as amended by the Local Government Fiscal
2 Assistance Act Amendments of 1983 (Pub. L. 98-185) authorizes the
3 appropriation of General Revenue Sharing funds to legible state and
4 local governments; and

5
6 WHEREAS, The Papago Tribe of Arizona is an eligible local government entitled
7 to general revenue funds and the Tribe's entitlement totals
8 \$203,536.00; and

9 WHEREAS, The major objective of the Revenue Sharing Act is to disburse federal
10 funds with minimum restrictions on use, and to permit local
11 governments to determine the programs and activities to be funded from
12 general revenue sharing funds; and

13 WHEREAS, The Papago Council has satisfied the requirements set forth in the
14 Federal Register for receipt of general revenue sharing funds; and

16 WHEREAS, The Papago Council has found that each of the eleven districts are
17 best suited and in a position to determine the needs of its citizens;
18 and

19 WHEREAS, The Papago Council recognizes the special needs of handicapped
20 persons.


21 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that General Revenue
22 Sharing funds for entitlement period October 1, 1985 to September 30,
23 1986 shall be equally distributed to each of the eleven districts of
24 the Papago Tribe, such amount to be \$15,146.00; and that each of the
25 districts will assess the needs of its handicapped citizens and use
26 funds in accordance therewith; and

28 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Papago Council that \$36,930 is reserved for
29 administration.

30 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 10th day
31 of October, 1985, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
32 1640.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting; and 02 absent, pursuant to the
authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 3 (a) and (h) of Article V of

1 the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended,
2 ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the
3 Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act
4 of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as of the date
5 of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is subject to
6 review by the Secretary of the Interior.
