

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

(Proposal for Tribal Education Standards Development)

RES. NO. 789-85

1 WHEREAS, the Papago Tribal Council did adopt the Comprehensive Education Plan  
2 (CEP) on April of 1983; and

3 WHEREAS, one objective in this plan clearly calls for the need for tribal  
4 education standards; and

5 WHEREAS, discretionary funds through the Indian Education Act, Title IV, Part  
6 b, are available for education related projects and programs; and

7 WHEREAS, the O'Odham Education Department in cooperation with State Department  
8 of Education have developed a proposal entitled Collaborative Effort  
9 to Develop Tribal Education Standards; and

10 WHEREAS, the Papago Education Committee/Board of Directors has reviewed such  
11 proposal and feels that, if funded, will contribute to the attainment  
12 of goals outlined in the Comprehensive Education Plan; and


13 WHEREAS, the Papago Education Committee/Board of Directors fully supports and  
14 authorizes the submission of this proposal.

15 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Papago Tribal Council does hereby  
16 authorize the submission of the proposal entitled Collaborative Effort  
17 to Develop Tribal Education Standards.

18 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman, Vice-Chairman and the Tribal  
19 Treasurer are hereby authorized and directed to negotiate the  
20 contract.

21 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 10th day  
22 of October, 1985, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of  
23 1640.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting; and 02 absent, pursuant to the  
24 authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (a) and (h) of Article V of  
25 the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended, ratified  
26 by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the  
27 Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934  
28 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the Secretary of  
29 the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by the Papago  
30 Council.
