necessary to an informed decision thereon; and

WHEREAS, no response has been received thereto and the questions remain unanswered.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby request from the Area Director to respond to the letter of Strickland & Altaffer dated April 27, 1984, within 30 days in order to permit this Council to effectively address the problem involving the title conflict of the land adjoining the site of the Sil Murk Cemetary.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman and Vice-Chairman follow through on this matter.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 6th day of November, 1985, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1640.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting; and -0- absent, pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (e) and (f) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by the Papago Council.
