

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL
(Title Conflict to Sil Murk Cemetary Land)

RES. NO. 837-85

1 WHEREAS, the Area Director did by letter dated April 2, 1984, advise this
2 Council that studies conducted by the BIA on the Gila Bend Reservation
3 in connection with the land exchange authorized under the Southern
4 Water Settlement Act revealed a possible title conflict involving
5 about 59 acres of land adjoining the site of the Sil Murk Cemetary,
6 and suggested that the Tribe discuss the matter with its attorneys;

8 and

9 WHEREAS, the tribal attorneys did review the matter and did by letter dated
10 April 27, 1984, ask the Area Director to answer a number of questions
11 necessary to an informed decision thereon; and


12 WHEREAS, no response has been received thereto and the questions remain
13 unanswered.

14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby
15 request from the Area Director to respond to the letter of Strickland
16 & Altaffer dated April 27, 1984, within 30 days in order to permit
17 this Council to effectively address the problem involving the title
18 conflict of the land adjoining the site of the Sil Murk Cemetary.

20 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman and Vice-Chairman follow through on
21 this matter.

22 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 6th day
23 of November, 1985, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
24 1640.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting; and -0- absent, pursuant to the
25 authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (e) and (f) of Article V of
26 the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended, ratified
27 by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the
28 Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934
(48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the Secretary of
the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by the Papago
Council.
