

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

(Referring HICKIWAN Community Water Service Needs to IHS)

RES. NO. 839-85

1 WHEREAS, the HICKIWAN District Council did on August 16, 1985 by Resolution  
2 No. 4-85 ask the Papago Council for assistance in obtaining a replace-  
3 ment well, or the conversion of the existing well serving the  
4 HICKIWAN Community; and



6 WHEREAS, the Papago Council believes that this is the obligation of the United  
7 States and the Indian Health Service and that the trust funds  
8 available to the Papago Tribe under the provisions of Section 309 of  
9 the Southern Arizona Water Rights Settlement Act, P.L. 97-293 (96  
10 Stat. 127 (4) cannot therefore be used for such purposes; and

11 WHEREAS, the Papago Council concurs with the HICKIWAN District and believes  
12 that providing the HICKIWAN Community with proper water services is  
13 a matter of first priority.

15 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that the Environmental  
16 Health Director of the Indian Health Service is requested to develop  
17 a solution to meet the water service needs of the HICKIWAN Community  
18 and to advise the Chairman of the Papago Tribe and the HICKIWAN  
19 District of such solution within thirty (30) days.

20 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 7th day  
21 of November, 1985, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of  
22 1581.5 for; 58.5 against; -0- not voting; and 01 absent, pursuant to the  
23 authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (d) and (f) of Article V of  
24 the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended, ratified  
25 by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the  
26 Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934  
(48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the Secretary of  
the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by the Papago  
Council.
